

Darryl Rensmon Named President of MMSC

The Morrison-Maierle Board of Directors is pleased to announce the election of Darryl Rensmon as President of Morrison-Maierle network subsidiary, Morrison-Maierle Systems Corporation (MMSC). Effective January 1, Darryl succeeded Jim Maierle as President of MMSC. As Morrison-Maierle's Chief Information Officer, Darryl has been responsible for general business management of MMSC since 2000. As President of MMSC, he will continue in that role and Jim Maierle will continue to serve as Chairman of the Board of MMSC.



Working with Harry Houze, MMSC Director of Operations and Helena Branch Manager; Wes Peltzer, Billings Branch Manager; and the other exceptional people of MMSC, Darryl and the MMSC team have successfully grown the staff and expanded the computer network services offered by the firm. In 2000, with Darryl's leadership, the company's management team and staff began building a new business model for MMSC and developing a strategic plan for the company. That effort was instrumental in expanding System's operation to Billings in 2002 and to Bozeman in 2003. An Arizona operation in Phoenix was added in 2005. Also in 2005, a full web management and design capability was added to the business services.

Morrison-Maierle Systems Corp. has been providing computer services since 1982. With the assistance and support of MMSC's committed technical and sales team, the company's reputation has grown steadily and is recognized as a leader in the computer services field serving financial institutions, professional businesses, local government, and industry. From a staff of four located in one office in 1999, MMSC has grown to a staff of 15 in four offices, including a full web design firm. MMSC revenues have increased 275% since 2001.

Darryl has 25 years of experience in computer-oriented work in the fields of engineering and information systems. He began as a CADD draftsman in civil, subdivision, and transportation engineering.
